

<caption> - TAG IN HTML

- The <caption> element specifies the **title of a table**.
- Yet it is always the first child of a <table> tag.
- The <caption> tag must be included instantly after the <table> tag.
- The <caption> tag supports **Global Attributes** and **Event Attributes**.

Syntax for caption tag:

```
<caption> content </caption>
```

Differences between HTML 4.01 and HTML5 for caption tag:

HTML 4.01

- <align> is supported in HTML 4.01

HTML5

- <align> is removed in HTML 5.

Sample coding for caption tag:



Annotation 1 (red circle) points to the `<caption>` tag. Annotation 2 (red circle) points to the text "WIKITECHY WEBSITE".

1. **<caption> tag** - is used for description of the table.
2. **WIKITECHY WEBSITE** is declared as the title of the table.
